

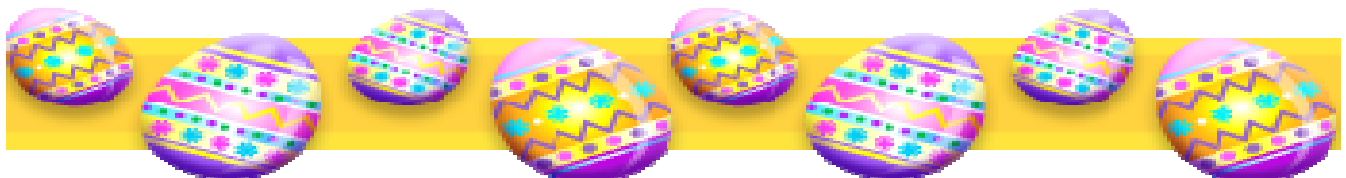

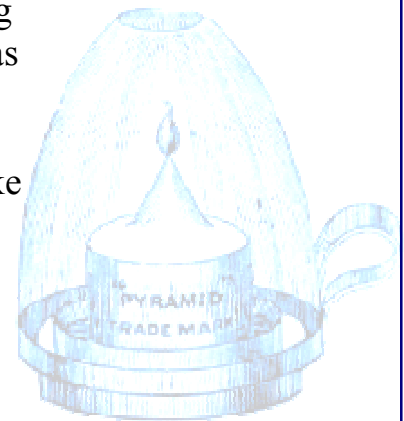


## MARCH'S PRESENTATION
